VOGUE KNITTING (ON THE WEB) FALL 2007 INSTRUCTIONS

JACKET AND PANTS

Oversized kimono-style jacket with ¾ balloon sleeves and loose-fitting pants both made with multiple squares which are formed by 4 triangles. Jacket is sized for one size fits most; pants are for one size to fit Small/Medium, and shown on pages 166 and 167.



KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Jacket

- Bust (buttoned) 48"/122cm; Length 25"/63.5cm
- Hip 38"/96.5cm; Length 30"/76cm

MATERIALS

For Jacket

- 3 13/4 oz/50g skeins (each approx 175yd/160m) of Koigu Wool Designs KPPPM in 2425 (MC)
- 2 skeins each in P111, P118B, P142, P146, P132, P335, P407, P441, P5116, P5110, P525D, P527, P535, P615, P815, P830L and P900

For Pants

- 16 skeins in P830D (A); 2 skeins in 2425 (B)
- One pair size 3 (3.25mm) needles OR SIZE TO **OBTAIN GAUGE**
- 1 set (4) dpn size 3 (3.25mm) dpn for sleeve cuffs
- Size 3 (3.25mm) circular needle 29"/75cm long for waistband of pants
- Size D-3 (3.25mm) crochet hook
- Approx 2,150 assorted 4mm beads
- Waistband elastic 1/2"/13mm wide; 30"/76cm for sleeve cuffs on jacket and 30"/76cm for pants

GAUGES

- 1 small square = $2\frac{1}{2}$ "/6.5cm (after blocking) using size 3 (3.25mm) needles.
- 1 large square = 4"/10cm (after blocking) using size 3 (3.25mm) needles. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGES.

SMALL SQUARE

Note Square begins with one triangle, then the other three triangles are picked up, one at a time, along the edges to form the square.

TRIANGLE 1-

Left angle triangle over 13 cast-on sts

Cast on 13 sts.

Row 1 (WS) K12, p1.

Row 2 Sl 1, k9, k2tog, p1.

Row 3 and all WS rows Sl 1, k to last st, pl.

Row 4 Sl 1, k8, k2tog, p1.

Row 6 Sl 1, k7, k2tog, p1.

Row 8 Sl 1, k6, k2tog, p1.

Row 10 Sl 1, k5, k2tog, p1.

Row 12 Sl 1, k4, k2tog, p1. Row 14 Sl 1, k3, k2tog, p1.

Row 16 Sl 1, k2, k2tog, p1.

Row 18 Sl 1, k1, k2tog, p1.

Row 20 Sl 1, k2tog, p1.

Row 22 Sl 1, k2tog, psso.

Row 23 K1, cut yarn and fasten off last st.

TRIANGLE 2—

Left angle triangle over 13 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 13 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 1. Work rows 1-23 of triangle 1.

TRIANGLE 3—

Left angle triangle over 13 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 13 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 2. Work rows 1-23 of

TRIANGLE 4—

Left angle triangle over 13 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 13 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 3. Work rows 1-23 of triangle 1. To create square, sew straight edge of triangle 4 to cast-on edge of triangle 1.

LARGE SQUARE

Note Square begins with one triangle, then the other three triangles are picked up, one at a time, along the edges to form the square.

TRIANGLE 1-

Left angle triangle over 21 cast-on sts

Cast on 21 sts.

Row 1 (WS) K20, p1.

Row 2 Sl 1, k17, k2tog, p1.

Row 3 and all WS rows Sl 1, k to last st, p1.

Row 4 Sl 1, k16, k2tog, p1.

Row 6 Sl 1, k15, k2tog, p1.

Row 8 Sl 1, k14, k2tog, p1.

Row 10 Sl 1, k13, k2tog, p1.

Row 12 Sl 1, k12, k2tog, p1. Row 14 Sl 1, k11, k2tog, p1.

Row 16 Sl 1, k10, k2tog, p1.

Rows 18-39 Rep rows 2-23 of small square.

TRIANGLE 2—

Left angle triangle over 21 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 21 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 1. Work rows 1-39 of triangle 1.

TRIANGLE 3—

Left angle triangle over 21 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 21 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 2. Work rows 1–39 of triangle 1.

TRIANGLE 4— Left angle triangle over 21 picked sts

With RS facing, pick up and k 21 sts along rows of straight edge of triangle 3. Work rows 1-39 of triangle 1.

To create square, sew straight edge of triangle 4 to cast-on edge of triangle 1.

JACKET

Make 40 small squares and 48 large squares following the diagram for colors.

Joining squares

Block all squares to measurements. With MC and using diagram for reference, sew squares tog that are indicated by a red line. Join the rem squares, indicated by a purple line, with crochet hook and MC as foll: with WS of squares tog (RS is facing) sc into stitch or row of each side to be joined. Leave the sides of the 10 small squares at the lower edge unjoined for flaps.

LEFT & FRONT

Make 54 small squares and 6 large squares for each front, following the diagram for colors. Block all squares to measurements. Join the squares as described for back and foll diagram for placement.

FINISHING

With crochet hook and MC, join shoulder seams and top of sleeve seams with sc, leaving center 21/2 squares at top unsewn for collar (see diagram).

Collar

With RS facing and MC, pick up and k 100 sts evenly around neck edge. [P 1 row, k 5 rows] 3 times. Work in St st for 18 rows. Bind off. Fold band in half to WS and sew in place.

With crochet hook and MC, join side seams with sc (the bottom row of small squares at the back hang free). Join sleeve seams with sc.

Lower edge border


With RS facing, MC and crochet hook, work 2 rows of sc evenly along lower edge of left front, around each flap of back and lower edge of right front.

With RS facing, dpn and MC, pick up and k 96 sts evenly along lower edge of each sleeve. Join to work in rnds as foll:

Rnd 1 [K6, k2tog] 12 times—84 sts.

Rnd 2 [K5, k2tog] 12 times—72 sts.

QUARE TEMPL ATE



8tch Key

Sewn join

Cast on edge

p/u Picked up edge

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Rnd 3 [K7, k2tog] 8 times—64 sts. P 4 rnds, [k 2 rnds, p 4 rnds] twice. K15 rnds.

Next rnd [K8, M1] 8 times—72 sts.

Next rnd [K6, M1] 12 times—84 sts.

Next rnd [K7, M1] 12 times—96 sts. K 1 rnd. Bind off sts loosely. Measure band around arm just above elbow for a snug fit and cut two pieces to fit this measurement. Sew the ends tog to form a circle. Fold cuff in half over elastic band circle so that the band sits under the fold. Secure band to inside of cuff and sew cuff in place on WS.

Left front border

String approx 130 beads on MC. With RS facing and crochet hook, work 1 row sc evenly along left front edge. Ch 1, turn. Work 1 row of sc, adding a bead to every st as foll: *move bead up the yarn until it is close to the work. Keeping the bead in back of the work (so that it shows on the RS) work sc in next st; rep from * to end. Work 2 rows more sc. Fasten off. Work right front border in same way.

Buttons (make 2)

String 50 beads on MC. With crochet hook and MC, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1 Work 10 sc in ring.

Rnd 2 Work sc in each sc.

Rnd 3 *Bring up bead and work 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around—20 sc and 10 bead.

Rnds 4 and 5 Sc in each sc, using a bead for each st. Fasten off.

Button loop

With 2 dpn and MC, cast on 4 sts.

*Row 1 (RS) K4. Do not turn. Slide sts to beg of needle to work next row from RS. Rep from * until cord measures 7"/17.5cm. Bind off. Sew cast-on and bound-off edge tog. Wrap yarn around center to make two loops. Sew a button to top of each front edge. Secure with button loop (see photo).

PANTS

BACK

With A, make 28 large squares. Join squares as for jacket, foll diagram for placement.

FRONT

Work same as back.

Beaded strip (make 2)

String approx 900 beads on B and cast on 8 sts. K 1 row.

Beaded row K1, [k next st with bead] 6 times, k1. **Next row** (WS) Knit. Rep last 2 rows until strip fits along side edge of pant leg. K 1 row without beads and bind off. Sew strips to front and back to join the legs.

GUSSET

With A, cast on 18 sts and work in St st for 24 rows. Bind off. Fold in half to form a triangle and sew to side of front and back at the crotch (see diagram).

Waistband

With RS facing, circular needle and A, pick up and k 172 sts evenly along top of pants. Join and [p 1 md, k 1 md] 6 times. K 6 mds. P 1 md for turning ridge. K 6 mds. Bind off loosely. Fold band at turning ridge to WS for casing and sew in place, leaving an opening for elastic. Thread elastic through casing, adjust to fit and sew remaining end closed. �
